FERION SKY raced close up to the outside, bid and dueled in the second turn, rallied and led in mid stretch. VINTAGE KING was slow early, gained ground to the outside, rallied four wide and closed well to finish second best. GRANITE POINT set a pressured pace on the rail but weakened in mid stretch and faded. LYNNWOOD lacked early speed, gained ground, rallied four wide into the stretch and gained ground. FIRST FIRE broke sharply, pressed the pace on the rail but weakened in the second turn and faded. SIR SITS A LOT contended on the rail but weakened in the second turn and faded. SLEWS ACADEMY was slow early, raced to the outside and showed a mild rally. MYSTICAL STORM stalked the pace to the outside but weakened in the second turn, entered the stretch three wide and tired.
