Footnotes

MOONLIGHT RULER broke sharply to set the pace and assumed command in the backstretch. KAT DESIGN stalked the lead from three wide, rallied in the upper stretch and prevailed for place. REGAL ROSETTI stalked the lead on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch but was outfinished for the place. FESTEEM was off slowly, saved ground, gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide into the stretch and finished well. FROSTY FORTY stalked the lead from between horses but weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. DARKWOOD LAKE saved ground, raced evenly, no threat. SIXTYEIGHTH AVENUE raced evenly to the outside and flattened out in the stretch. TRICKY NOT CREEPY was slow early and raced evenly to the outside. BING GO lacked speed, entered the first turn three wide, saved ground in the backstretch but dropped back steadily.
