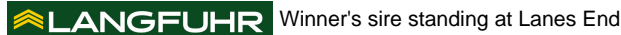

Footnotes

BOADINI raced evenly on the rail, gained steadily, rallied three wide and closed fast. OFFLEE FANCEE stalked three wide, gained ground in the second turn, led into the stretch but weakened late. POLAR raced evenly while three wide, ran evenly then rallied three wide in the upper stretch and finished well. MAXIMUS POTENTIAL lacked early speed, raced evenly, gained ground, rallied in the upper stretch for a late gain. JACKMAN raced close up while four wide, bid four wide in the second turn but faded in the stretch. DEJA VROOM VROOM broke sharply, dueled on the rail, got through on the rail in the upper stretch but faded. HONEY'S MONARCH got away slowly, raced three wide, dropped back to trail. COUNTDOWN AT CAPE saved ground and was never a factor. OH TO BE LUCKY broke sharply, dueled to the outside but weakened in the second turn and gave way.
