BAD BIG AL dueled to the inside of POWERFUL SUMMER, opened a lead late in the second turn, drifted out entering the upper stretch, rallied and held well. GREENWOOD MEADOW raced three wide early, stalked the pace, gained ground in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and held well. MOCHA JOHN came out in the first turn, continued evenly, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, altered course in mid stretch and closed late. LAUROYLYMPIO was carried out entering the first turn, saved ground in the backstretch, gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide and finished well. CHIEF'S MAGIC saved ground early but dropped back in the backstretch, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide and finished well. A. K.'S DANCER raced evenly to the outside, rallied into the upper stretch and finished evenly.. BEAU BRASS was off slowly, trailed, passed tiring rivals. AIRO FAITH raced evenly to the outside and was not a factor. POWERFUL SUMMER broke sharply, dueled to the outside of BAD BIG AL but weakened after the quarter pole and gave way.
