BEAU DIABLO dueled twice to the outside, was headed in the upper stretch, came again to get up late. HERCULEAN dueled on the rail, made a bid in the second turn, led late but was outfinished. CATTLE HAULER saved ground, stalked the early pace but weakened in the backstretch and chased the lead in the stretch. TWAY lacked speed early, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. CAPE AND GOWN stalked to the outside, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back. SKEW BALL raced evenly on the rail, weakened in the second turn and tired.
