SIN TORO stalked the pace to the outside, made a bid in the second turn, led in the upper stretch and held well. TOBY BAY saved ground and raced evenly then rallied on the rail into the upper stretch and closed well. BEAR CHARACTER lacked speed, raced evenly then gained ground in the second turn, rallied, and finished well. STORMIN' PATRICK broke well, set a pressured pace, but weakened after the quarter pole HONEST BREW lacked early speed, ran evenly, rallied five wide and finished well. BOULDER HAT had a slow start, raced evenly on the rail but was no factor. PETE AFLEET pressed the pace to the outside, made a mild bid into the second turn and tired in the stretch. SIR SITS A LOT raced three early, moved to the rail. in the rail backstretch, failed to rally and gave way in the stretch.
