Footnotes

PASEO ALEGRO lacked early speed, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied, and closed stretch. TINY GIANT broke sharply to set a pressured pace, drew clear but tired in the stretch. GATWICK pressed the pace to the outside, faded in the backstretch but rallied for a late gain. FOOTPRINT ran evenly, dropped back in the second turn, rallied and finished well. READY RACER dwelt, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well. ZURI MWANA stalked the pace on the rail but weakened in the second turn and faded. GRAT SUBSTITUTION contended from the outside, raced evenly but faded in the stretch. QUECHEE lacked speed and showed a mild rally. COOL DIABLO lacked speed on the rail, dropped back and was never factor. INUIT FISHER stalked early pace, weakened backstretch, dropped back.
