SEA CURRENT stalked the lead to the outside, bid four wide in the second turn and drew clear in the stretch. SHAW'S HONOR dueled to the inside of A NEW JEWEL but weakened and dropped back in the second turn and finished second best. WILD YOUNG COWBOY lacked speed, saved ground, gained ground steadily in the second turn, rallied and closed the gap on place. JOAN'S REMARK was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied five wide and finished well. TWO POINT TONY raced three wide early but weakened along the backstretch, raced evenly and finished with a mild rally. A NEW LEVEL dueled to the outside of SHAW'S HONOR but weakened in the backstretch and faded in the stretch. RANGLIN ROAD lacked speed, raced to the outside and was no factor. MARDI GRAU GLITTER stalked the pace on the rail, weakened in the second turn, entered the stretch three wide and tired.
