### Footnotes

JEFFREY'S GROOVE got away on the rail, dueled, led into the upper stretch and held well. SAND BANDIT broke in air, had a steady advance, bid three wide, closed fast and was probably the best. TRIP THE GENERAL dueled while on the outside, rallied upper in the stretch and weakened mid stretch to be third. FIRST FIRE was three wide in the first turn, chased the leaders and flattened out in the second turn. MR. SHADAR saved ground along the rail, ran evenly, weakened in the second turn and faded. LONGBOAT KEY was three wide in the first turn, trailed, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well. ROAD TALK stayed on the rail, chased down the backstretch, weakened at the quarter pole and dropped back. BOONSTOCK wide in the second turn and gave way in the stretch. AGAINST THE TIDE was slow early and not a factor. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL raced from the rail, stalked the pace, had no rally and gave way.
