Footnotes

RECOUNTED saved ground early, dueled to the outside in the backstretch, led at the quarter pole, rallied and held well. DEBIE GINSBURG was caught four wide early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide, closed well but broke down after the finish. SAINT'S ECHO dueled on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. COURTLY SLEW chased the pace evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied in the upper stretch but weakened. LONDON LASS lacked early speed, raced between rivals, gained ground in the backstretch and rallied for a late gain. IN FORMATION was slow early, trailed and passed tiring rivals. DRIVEN BY SEATTLE was slow early, ran evenly and was no threat. INTERVENTION lacked early speed, entered the first turn three, gained ground in the backstretch but gave way in the second turn.
