Footnotes

CANDY FOR PASEANA raced evenly from between rivals, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and drew clear late. FANTANDO (GB) raced three wide into the first turn, contended, rallied three wide and finished second best. CONSTABLE SHEPPARD dwelt and trailed early, gained ground steadily in the second turn, rallied three wide and finished well. FIRST FIRE broke sharply, stalked the pace, rallied three wide and finished evenly. SLEWS ACADEMY saved ground, closed in the second turn, rallied four wide and gained ground. VINTAGE KING lacked early speed and trailed, rallied four wide and gained ground.. GRANITE POINT rushed to the lead, pressed the pace to the outside but weakened in the second turn and gave way. COOL REVELATION set a pressured pace on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole and tired.
