### Footnotes

STEADY PACE dueled to the outside, rallied stretch, finished all out to prevail. KELLYS GUEST broke sharply, dueled on the rail but was outfinished. GLAD'S AND ROSE'S raced evenly to the outside early, stalked the pace in the backstretch and finished evenly. TORNADO VALLEY saved ground, raced evenly, rallied into the upper stretch and gained ground late. HEIDI'S ROSETTE raced four wide early and was taken back to race along the rail in the backstretch and showed a mild rally. ACTSENSUAL lacked speed, entered the first turn three wide, moved to the rail in the backstretch then rallied four wide into the stretch and gained ground. LAURA E. broke sharply, was three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace, rallied three wide but faded. MUNDARE raced evenly to the outside, rallied four wide in the upper stretch but failed to threaten. JOEY'S LAST RIDE saved ground, raced evenly, showed little. FUSION WELD raced close up on the rail but gave way in the backstretch and was pulled up in the second turn.
