BAD BIG AL vied for the lead from three wide, opened a lead in the upper stretch and prevailed. DIAMOND DOC vied for the from between rivals, rallied into the upper stretch but was outfinished. BALLINTOY stalked the lead on the rail but weakened in the second turn and finished evenly. SMILE N WAVE saved ground, raced evenly but weakened in the second turn and dropped back. AGAINST THE TIDE lacked speed, raced evenly and passed tiring rivals. LEONIDES vied for the lead on the rail but weakened in the second turn and dropped back in the stretch. ORIGINAL INK lacked early, dropped back steadily, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
