Footnotes

ANN CAN stalked the pace on the rail, bid in the upper stretch, dueled with MONDAY MYSTERY and prevailed. MONDAY MYSTERY was urged to contend early, stalked the pace, bid three wide in the second turn, dueled in the stretch but was outfinished. ACTSENSUAL raced close up from between rivals, closed ground along the rail rallied and chased the leaders in the stretch. HAPPY'S AFLEET was slow early, raced evenly and showed a mild rally to gain ground in the stretch. SWEET OBSESSION raced evenly from between rivals, weakened in the backstretch and faded. MONTANA TRAIL was used early to take the early lead, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back. REAL DILEMMA raced evenly from close up on the rail but weakened in the backstretch and faded. MAUI GOLD was caught three wide entering the first turn but dropped back steadily. STOLE AGAIN was off slowly, dropped back early and was distanced and eased.
