GOLD OMEGA rushed to the lead, drew clear in the first turn, drew off in the stretch. SNAZZYBOY entered the first turn three wide, stalked the pace but weakened in the second turn and finished second best. JOAN'S REMARK lacked speed, raced to the outside, entered the stretch four wide and finished evenly. WILD YOUNG COWBOY saved ground, raced evenly, got through on the rail in the second turn and showed a mild rally in the upper stretch. DIVINITY was forced out five wide in the first turn, gained ground, was three wide in the stretch and finished well. LONGBOAT KEY chased the lead from between horses, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. WAGEL ROCK was off slowly, drifted four wide in the first turn, continued to the outside and gave way. MR. SIRROCCO stalked the pace on the rail but weakened in the backstretch and gave way.
