ROBO WILLIE stalked the leader, made a bid entering the second turn, vied for the lead from between rivals, rallied into the stretch, opened a lead through the stretch and held well late. CASEY'S ON CALL raced close up from three wide, gained ground then bid three wide entering the second turn, vied for the lead, rallied in the upper stretch but was outfinished. IT'S GOOD TO BE ME stalked the pace on the rail, advanced steadily on the rail, rallied three wide into the stretch and closed late. RUMBLE RUCKUS set the early pace, vied for the lead when challenged in the second turn but weakened in the upper stretch and faded. QUIET APPROACH was slow early, raced evenly, rallied into the upper stretch and passed tiring rivals. MR. SHADAR raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, but flattened out in the stretch. MT. DAVIDSON was slow early, entered the first turn three wide, raced evenly but weakened. RONOH saved ground, raced evenly, showed a mild rally and faded in the stretch. COOL DIABLO lacked speed, raced evenly then gained ground in the backstretch but flattened out.
