Footnotes

MOUNTAIN MINISTER contended evenly on the rail, gained ground but rallied and finished well. CAESAR'S SON saved ground, set a pressured pace, led into the stretch and drew clear. SIX O NINE saved ground, stalked in the backstretch, weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. BROTHER PATRICK raced three wide, bid close up, rallied four wide but faded. LEAP YEAR LOOT ran evenly from between rivals, made a mild rally into the stretch but weakened. DUKE IT OUT raced four wide into the first turn, stalked the pace, failed to rally and faded in the stretch. KISSIN WIZARD lacked early, saved ground and raced evenly. GOLD KID was slow early, raced three into the first turn and was never a factor.
