Footnotes

NELLIE'S GENIUS angled in at the start, vied for the lead on the rail, edged ahead after the quarter pole and drew clear in the stretch. SHAW'S HONOR stalked the pace on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and closed to get up for place. CLASSIC DRUMMER vied for the lead from three wide, weakened near the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. WILD YOUNG COWBOY bobbed at the start and trailed, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide into the stretch and closed. JIM'S CHOICE was shuffled back and bobbed at the start then raced evenly on the rail. REGAL CHIMERA raced evenly to the outside but flattened out in the stretch. JUST TRIPPINALONG vied for the lead from between rivals but weakened in the second turn and faded. BEARAHEAD raced evenly to the outside, weakened after the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch.
