Footnotes

BOULDER HAT stalked the pace from three wide, made a bid entering the second turn, dueled to the outside of STEPH IN TIME, drew clear. MARIA'S TOUCH raced evenly to the outside, gained ground while three wide in the second turn, rallied three wide and closed. LIGHT OF GOLD stalked the pace from between rivals, raced evenly but weakened at the quarter pole and finished evenly stretch. STEPH IN TIME broke well to set the pace, dueled in the second turn but weakened in mid stretch. JAMMIN JAZZ saved ground early, gained ground on the rail in the second turn, rallied into the stretch but flattened out late. JOAN'S REMARK was slow early, trailed and dropped back in the stretch. LITTLE GRIZZ raced close up on the rail but weakened in the backstretch and dropped back in the second turn.
