Footnotes

KEOWEE CLAI dueled on the rail, opened a lead in the second turn and drew clear in the stretch. CRAFTY CRITTER dueled to the outside, weakened near the quarter pole but finished second best. COURTLY SLEW was shuffled back at the start, raced six wide early, continued evenly, gained ground in the second turn and made a mild bid. SAINT'S ECHO broke inward at the start and bumped with COURTLY SLEW, raced five wide early, ran evenly, made a mild bid and gained ground late. MISS OOPS was bumped repeatedly after the start, raced five wide early, contended but weakened in the second turn. CHATAHOOCHEIE ran evenly to the outside but flattened out in the stretch. RECOUNTED lunged at the start, stalked the pace on the rail but weakened in the backstretch and dropped back. LITTLE TRAPPER broke outward and was bumped at the start, raced four wide early, dropped back and trailed.
