STOLE AGAIN stalked the pace to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, made a bid in the upper stretch and finished well. REAL DILEMMA saved ground, ran evenly, gained steadily, got through on the rail in the upper stretch and closed ground. UNSWEETENED lacked speed early, ran evenly, rallied six wide and closed fast. MONDAY MYSTERY dueled to the outside, led after the quarter pole, dueled again in the stretch but weakened in mid stretch. BOXCARS raced three wide into the first turn, dropped back in the backstretch, bid five wide in the upper stretch and gained ground. AUNT JOYCE stalked the pace on the rail, weakened in the second turn, entered the stretch three wide but failed to rally. SHAMUS ON ME saved ground, ran evenly, rallied four wide and finished evenly. HIGHLAND FIRE lacked speed, saved ground, entered the stretch six wide but faded. TIKA TWO broke sharply, dueled on the rail but weakened at the quarter pole and dropped back.
