Footnotes

APILONIA raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, rallied, closed and got up late. GLAD'S AND ROSE'S set the early pace on the rail then dueled with LITTLE MISS JO, dropped back in the second turn, came again to duel in the stretch but just failed to last. WINTER CHILL raced evenly, contended then rallied four wide and finished well. PAPOOSE DANCER stalked the pace on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, bid there wide into the upper stretch but weakened. ACTSENSUAL was off slowly, brushed, raced evenly and was no threat. JOEY'S LAST RIDE was slow early, saved ground dropped back in the backstretch and trailed. LITTLE MISS JO pressed the pace to the outside, bid and dueled in the backstretch, led at the quarter pole but tired and gave way. HEIDI'S ROSETTE was three wide in the first turn, contended but weakened in the second turn and gave way.
