DUDE LIT dueled to the outside, drew clear in the second turn and drew off in the stretch. DEPUTY VAL WEST stalked the pace on the rail, rallied into the upper stretch and finished second best. CHANCE REMARK stalked the pace on the rail, raced evenly, weakened in the second turn, but rallied into the stretch but faded. DREAMING DANCER dueled on the rail, weakened after the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch. CHEROKEE R N came in at the start and bumped, raced evenly on the rail and dropped back in the backstretch. TRIBAL Z broke out, raced evenly on the rail and was never a factor. COBRA CAT was squeezed back at the start, raced evenly to the outside and failed to menace.
