ROLLETTI rail, set the pace, drew clear in the backstretch and finished evenly. BLACKCOMB RUN raced evenly to the outside, gained ground steadily, rallied in the upper stretch and closed the gap. PAPA TIME lacked speed early, raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the third turn and chased in the stretch. WILD YOUNG COWBOY saved ground, trailed and showed a mild bid. YANKEE COLONEL stalked the pace to the outside, bid three wide in the second turn, ran evenly but flattened out. ARGENTUNE saved ground, raced evenly but gave way in the second turn and trailed. MOSSBANK broke well on the rail, stalked the pace, made a bid in the second turn and gave way in the backstretch.
