SERVICE RIBBON stalked the pace to the outside, made a bid in the backstretch and drew clear in the second turn. PRETTY BEAUCAT saved ground, raced evenly and showed a mild rally. GLAD'S AND ROSE'S stalked the pace on the rail, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and gained ground late. SPEEDUBAI stalked three wide early but weakened in the second turn and chased in the stretch. BEAR'S HONEY broke sharply, saved ground but weakened in the backstretch. RIBBON CREEK lacked early speed, saved ground but dropped back and trailed.
