TAYLOR'S TALE pressed the pace to the outside, dueled in the backstretch, opened a lead after the quarter pole and drew off. SPORTIVE pressed the pace on the rail, stalked in the backstretch, rallied and held place. ICED MOCHA raced evenly on the rail, bid three wide in the backstretch, weakened in the second turn and faded. CASANOVA KING broke well, dropped back on the rail in the backstretch and trailed. WHAT'S UP DOC set the early pace on the rail, dueled in the backstretch but weakened near the quarter pole and dropped back. STRIKING TIME lacked speed and trailed, gained ground in the backstretch but weakened and dropped back in the second turn.
