Footnotes

EXPLOSIVE CHILL stalked the pace on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, slipped through in the upper stretch, lugged in and closed steadily. BIG GEORGE saved ground, dueled on the rail, led in the upper stretch, dueled in mid stretch but was outfinished. The rider on BIG GEORGE claimed foul on EXPLOSIVE CHILL for interference in the stretch. The claim of foul was not allowed. TWO TOM dueled on the outside but weakened in the upper stretch and was outfinished. SLY ROSSETTI saved ground, raced evenly then rallied into the stretch for a late gain. BALVENNIE was slow early, rallied and passed tiring rivals. BLUE COLLAR JOE gained ground steadily, was three wide at the quarter pole, showed a mild rally but faded in the stretch. FLYING GAS stalked the lead to the outside but weakened at the quarter pole and dropped back in the stretch. CANADIAN KING was slow early, saved ground, dropped back in the second turn and trailed.
