Footnotes

RAPID 'N READY pressed the pace to the outside of POWERFUL SUMMER, made a bid at the quarter pole, set the pace and drew off in the stretch. BLING entered the first turn three wide, stalked the pace on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch and finished second best. ALARICO was carried out four wide entering the first turn, gained ground on the rail, was blocked briefly then got through on the rail, rallied and finished evenly. POWERFUL SUMMER set a pressured pace on the rail but weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. SHPEEN was five wide in the first turn, dropped back to stalk the pace but weakened in the second turn. AIRO FAITH saved ground, raced evenly and made a mild rally. MOCHA JOHN was four wide into the first turn, dropped back and was no factor. CHIEF'S MAGIC entered the first turn three wide, drifted out, dropped back and trailed.
