SHORT MEMO broke well, dueled while on the rail, drew clear upper stretch and rode off. GENIUS LEVEL saved ground, raced evenly in the backstretch, rallied around the late turn and closed ground on all but the winner. LONGBOAT KEY showed no speed, trailed early, gave a steady gain and finished well. ACES AGAIN dueled while racing on the outside, tired slightly in the backstretch but found a mild rally to finish. SOUTHVIE INVADER had no speed and was not a factor. FIRST FIRE was three wide early, stalked the leaders, weakened in the second turn and then trailed.
