MONTERO vied for the lead from thee wide, opened a lead after the quarter rallied in the upper stretch and drew clear. DIXIETWOSTEPPER vied for the lead from wide early, weakened after the quarter pole but held well for the place. SHE'S ITALIAN saved ground, was blocked on the rail in the backstretch, altered course to the outside, gained ground steadily, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and faded in the stretch. SPEEDY GONE SALLY stalked the leaders from four wide, made a bid in the backstretch, but weakened in the second turn and faded in the stretch. TARTAN STAR was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied five wide into the stretch and finished well. BRAETTA was slow early, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied four wide into the stretch and finished well. SASSY SARAH stalked the pace on the rail, raced evenly but flattened out in the stretch. SHE'S TWENTY BELOW raced evenly from between horses, entered the stretch three wide and faded. PRETTY BEAUCAT vied for the lead on the rail, was in tight quarters entering the second turn, was taken back and dropped back. The rider on PETTY BEAUCAT claimed foul on SPEEDY GONE SALLY for interference entering the second turn. The claim of foul was not allowed.
