Footnotes

RAVALIN'S RAEZAR stalked the pace on the rail, closed on the rail but was blocked in the second turn, got through on the rail in the upper stretch and closed well. ICEY TEMPER dueled on the rail, rallied into the upper stretch but was outfinished. AYE AYE SIR drifted out entering the first turn, raced close up, bid three wide in the second turn but weakened in the stretch. HIGH BODGIT raced evenly on the rail, gained ground steadily, got through on the rail late in the second turn and showed a mild rally. LOGAN PASS angled in at the start and bumped SINGNONSUNDAY, raced evenly, gained ground steadily in the second turn and rallied five wide. DENNYDALE raced evenly on the rail but weakened in the stretch. P C'S RUCKUS dueled to the outside but weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. COAST TO COAST BOB was forced wide entering the first turn, contended wide but weakened in the second turn. SINGNONSUNDAY broke awkwardly then was bumped and forced into the gap and trailed.
