OH TO BE LUCKY saved ground, drew clear in the second turn and finished handily. SHANS VICTOR raced evenly, gained ground along the rail in the second turn but was in tight quarters was steadied then rallied into the stretch and finished well. BRADYS FRIENDS drifted out entering the first turn, moved to the rail in the backstretch, rallied three wide and finished well. PERFECTO CAT was carried out entering the first turn, stalked the pace then made a bid late in the backstretch but weakened in the second turn. BESNARD lacked speed, saved ground, gained ground from three wide in the backstretch but flattened out. LEN AGAIN trailed, no factor. SEEM'S TO BE was forced out entering first turn, bid three wide in the backstretch but weakened in the second turn and faded.
