Footnotes

LAMBEAU LEAP stalked the pace to the outside, bid and led after the quarter pole, rallied into the stretch and drew clear. GRANITE POINT dueled on the rail, weakened near the quarter pole, continued evenly in the stretch and held place. FANTANDO (GB) broke sharply, raced evenly on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well along the rail. DIVINE DEED raced three wide into the first turn, stalked the pace evenly, made a mild bid, but faded in the stretch. VINTAGE KING was slow early and trailed, rallied in the upper stretch and passed tiring rivals. THE CON IS SMILES raced evenly on the rail, rallied three wide but flattened out. HAWAIIAN RULER lacked early speed and showed little. COUNTDOWN AT CAPE ran evenly while between rivals, weakened in the backstretch and dropped back. ROWDY REMARK raced close up to the outside, weakened in the second turn and dropped back in the stretch.
