MISS BUNNY broke well, pressed the pace to the outside, dueled in the stretch, raced all out and prevailed. NASTY stalked the pace, made a bid in the upper stretch, dueled all out but was outfinished. ABSOLUTE SCANDAL raced evenly to the outside, rallied iupper stretch, gaining. NOT IN YOUR LEAGUE rail, set pace, weakened backstretch, faded stretch. SILVER CONTESSA lacked speed and trailed, gained ground, rallied and finished well. SHOE PENNY contended on the rail, weakened in the second turn but faded in the stretch. NOTICE THE WAVE was off slowly, raced evenly on the rail but was never a factor. PUKIMNA was slow early, ran evenly to the outside but weakened in the second turn and dropped back. EARLY NEWS dropped back early on the rail, stalked the pace and trailed in the stretch.
