BAD MEDICINE set a pressured pace on the rail, drew clear in the second turn, drifted into the stretch. OFFLEE FANCEE broke inward , raced evenly to the outside, gained ground in the second turn and rallied to finished second best. HALO'S HOUDINI pressed the pace to the outside but weakened in the second turn and dropped back in the stretch. HE'S A LADIES MAN was off slowly and shuffled back, trailed and showed a mild rally. COUNTDOWN AT CAPE stalked the pace on the rail, raced evenly but weakened and dropped back in the second turn.
