Footnotes

WILD CRUSH raced evenly on the rail, gained steadily, bid three wide in the third turn, rallied three wide and prevailed. JUST THE CASH vied for the lead from between rivals, made a bid in the third turn, dueled into the stretch but was outfinished. RAISE A DANE was slow early, raced evenly, rallied in the upper stretch and finished well. DOUBLE TOT was caught five wide early, vied for the lead while five wide but weakened in the backstretch and flattened out. BOLDEST MAX broke well, stalked on the rail, rallied four wide and finished well. OTTOSHINE vied on the rail, dueled in the backstretch but weakened after the quarter pole. SUPER DUPE vied three wide but weakened in the backstretch and dropped back. KOOL BUCKAROO lacked speed early, raced evenly on the rail and showed a mild rally. SIR BOBBSY lacked speed and trailed, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
