Footnotes

BELL ZONE stalked the pace to the outside, gained ground in the second turn, rallied three wide, closed steadily to get up late. CARDINAL ZIN raced evenly on the rail, closed steadily, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, rallied but was outfinished. CRIMINAL OFFENSE was used early to set the pace, weakened in the second turn but rallied and was outfinished. DEVILS AFLEET drifted entering the first turn, raced to the outside, rallied three wide and finished well. NO MO BAMBINO saved ground, raced evenly while close up, gained in the second turn and showed a mild rally. SUNNY BREAK drifted entering the first turn, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, bid four wide and closed well. GUITARS N CADILACS raced evenly from close up, rallied in the upper stretch but flattened out. GIN FIZZ saved ground, ran close up but flattened out in the stretch, WIRED TWO TWENTY was off slowly, trailed and was never a factor. SAX lacked no speed, showed little.
