THE WHAMMER dueled outside, was three wide early, led into the backstretch, rallied and prevailed. WHAT'S UP DOC stalked lead, bid in the backstretch and held place. NO MO BAMBINO raced on the outside evenly, rallied in the upper stretch then flattened out. MIGHTY BUCK lacked speed, stayed on the rail, had a steady gain in the second turn and finished well. VIMANA saved ground, raced evenly, closed ground in the second turn and hung. HARD TO BE HUMBLE chased the leaders, weakened in the second turn and dropped back. SHANS VICTOR no speed, raced evenly and was no factor. CRIMINAL OFFENSE was slow early, stayed on the rail, weakened in the second turn and gave way. GOOCHIO broke well, dueled, weakened in the backstretch and gave way in the stretch.
