HARDCORE CANDY dueled on the rail, dropped back then rallied three wide into the stretch and drew clear. AMONG THE WILLOWS was slow early, trailed, rallied four wide and closed fast. SPEEDY EYES dueled to the outside, raced evenly, rallied into the stretch but weakened. FUN RUNNER raced three wide early, ran evenly, rallied wide and finished well. DAKOTA RED rushed to contend, pressed the pace but weakened in the second turn. MAJAKAT lacked speed, raced evenly and was no factor. JANE DOE was jostled at the start, raced evenly on the rail but weakened and dropped back in the second turn. POWER BUTTON broke in a tangle, saved ground, made a quick move in the second turn, dueled but tired in the stretch.
