### Footnotes

TEJANO TROUBLE was taken back early, stalked the leaders, bid for the lead in the second turn, altered course inside entering the backstretch, vied for the lead on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch and drew clear after mid stretch. HURRICANE'S ASHORE was taken back early, saved ground, raced evenly, gained ground in the third turn, rallied four wide in the stretch and finished well. AMAZON RHYTHM dueled on the rail early, drifted out in the second turn, vied for the lead from between horses and weakened in the upper stretch. BANDERAS BAY was wide early, dueled to the outside of AMAZON RHYTHM, vied for lead from three wide along the backstretch, weakened in the third turn and faded. BEAR ATTITUDE was slow early, saved ground and raced evenly. STOLYA was slow early, raced evenly, weakened in the third turn and dropped back.
