WYE RED pressed the pace, bid in the second turn, vied for lead from between horses, rallied in the upper stretch and opened a lead in mid stretch. BETHUNE was four wide early, bid four wide in the second turn, vied for the lead from three wide along the backstretch but weakened in the upper stretch. MOCHA JOHN was three wide early, raced close up, rallied at the quarter pole, entered the stretch four wide stretch and finished evenly. FEVER raced evenly on the rail and showed a mild rally. NAPINOWAAN was four wide early and taken back, bid for the lead from three wide into the second turn, vied for lead on the rail along the backstretch but weakened in the at third turn and dropped back.
