TEAGUES FIGHT raced close up to the outside, gained ground steadily while three wide, opened a lead after the quarter pole, rallied in the upper stretch and held well. TRICK OF THE NORTH was slow early, raced evenly, gained steadily in the third turn, rallied in the stretch and held well for the place. TEST BOY was slow early, raced evenly, advanced steadily in the third turn, rallied but was outfinished for place. TEJANO TROUBLE raced evenly to the outside, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and finished well. PLAGIARIST stalked the lead from three wide but weakened in the third turn and faded in the stretch. PICKINONTHEOLBANJO raced close up on the rail but weakened in the third turn and faded in the stretch. LAKETON pressed the pace to the outside of LAKETON, led briefly in the backstretch but weakened after the quarter pole and faded. SUMMER SENSATION set a pressured pace on the rail, weakened along the backstretch, dropped back steadily and was eased. TIGER ENERGY saved ground, broke down in the first turn.
