Footnotes

BRIGADIER WINGATE pressed the pace from four wide, dueled to the outside in the second turn and prevailed. HAWKERS GATE vied for the lead from between rivals, dueled on the rail in the second turn but was outfinished. NOBLE TEXAS vied for the lead from three wide but weakened after the quarter pole and finished evenly. UP GRADER stalked he pace on the rail, gained ground and showed a mild rally three wide in the upper stretch. JUST TRIPPINALONG vied for the lead on the rail but weakened late in the backstretch and faded in the stretch. ITS LAUNCH TIME lacked speed and trailed. BROOKSIDE DRIVE raced five wide early, dropped back to stalk the pace to the outside but weakened in the second turn and dropped back.
