### Footnotes

TRUE METROPOLITAN saved ground and stalked the leaders, bid four wide in the late backstretch, opened a lead and drew off through the stretch. BEAU BRASS raced evenly, gained ground in the backstretch, bid five wide entering the third turn, rallied in the stretch and held place. ROYALTY BOY was slow early, gained ground in the third turn, rallied three wide in the upper stretch and was outfinished for the place. BONSPIEL saved ground, raced evenly, gained ground along the backstretch but flattened out in the stretch. CHURCHBRIDGE vied for lead from between horses, weakened late in the third turn and faded. THIEVERY vied for lead on the rail, weakened in the third turn and dropped back. COURTNEY BAY vied for lead while 3 wide, weakened in the third turn and gave way stretch.
