Footnotes

JACK ATTACK lacked early speed, gained ground on the rail but waited, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, rallied and prevailed. GEE IM JOE dueled on the rail, rallied in the upper stretch but was outfinished. KASINO BANDIT ran evenly, gained steadily while three wide, rallied three wide into the stretch but was outfinished. SOCKS ARE UP was used early, dueled to the outside but weakened in the third turn, bid three wide into the stretch but finished evenly. CORRIDOS stalked the pace on the rail, closed but was blocked on the rail entering the third turn n the backstretch, rallied into the stretch but gave way. FIVEPINS raced evenly on the rail but entered tight quarters in the third turn, was taken back and finished evenly. NEECHI'S REGAL SON broke sharply to the outside, dropped back and trailed. HARD TO BE HUMBLE raced five wide early, ran close up, entered the third turn five wide but weakened and dropped back.
