KOOL ATLANTIC lacked early speed, saved ground, gained ground steadily, rallied three wide and closed well. TURNAGAIN TAYLOR was slow early, raced evenly on the rail, gained ground in the second turn, rallied and finished well. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL dueled on the rail, weakened in the upper stretch. EXCESS BAGGAGE dueled to the outside, weakened in the upper stretch and faded. RATTLE THE CAGE was off slowly, raced three wide early, gained ground in the backstretch but weakened and faded. VICAR'S ICE PICK was off slowly, contended but weakened in the second turn and dropped back. CALIFORNIA SOLDIER had no speed, trailed, showed little. SUGAR KING saved ground, stalked the pace but weakened in the second turn, dropped back and trailed.
