VISION OF ROSES chased the lead on the rail, gained steadily, rallied four wide and closed fast. LIT'SGOODLOOKNGRAY was off slowly, lacked speed, gained ground but was blocked in the upper stretch, altered course four wide and closed well. LINDSEY'S STORM was forced wide early, raced three wide, made a bid at the quarter pole, led in the stretch but weakened. MILLWRIGHT drifted entering the first turn, gained ground, slipped through between rivals in the upper stretch and gained BLACK ROCK BURNER was slow early, raced evenly, rallied four wide and finished well. SPARHAWK stumbled at the start, gained ground steadily altered course four wide and finished well. OH TO BE LUCKY rushed to the lead, set the pace but weakened in the second turn, tired in the stretch.
