Footnotes

ALARICO raced three wide, gained ground in the backstretch, bid three wide into the stretch and prevailed. RAPID 'N READY stalked the pace on the rail, was blocked in the second turn, got through on the rail in the upper stretch, bid but was outfinished. GREENWOOD MEADOW raced evenly to the outside, gained ground steadily in the backstretch, rally four wide into the stretch but weakened. NECHAKO dropped back early, trailed, gained ground in the second turn and rallied for a late gain. BAD HAT was slow early, raced evenly but flattened out in the stretch. MARKET FORCE dueled to the outside of MR. EXCESSIVE but weakened after the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. MR. EXCESSIVE dueled on the rail but weakened in the second turn and dropped back steadily.
