YANKEE COLONEL stalked the early pace, made a bid in the second turn and vied for the lead from between rivals, rallied into the stretch and prevailed. CIELO E MAR raced three wide into the first turn, pressed the pace from three wide, bid and vied for the lead in the second turn, rallied but was outfinished. THINKIN POSITIVE drifted out in the first turn, raced evenly, gained ground in the second turn, rallied into the stretch and finished well. MY LUCKY THIRTEEN was off slowly then was forced outward in the first turn, gained ground then rallied five wide and closed. SHOW ME HOME saved ground, stalked the pace then swung four wide into the stretch and weakened. THAT'S A GOOD BOY drifted in the first turn, trailed then rallied into the stretch and finished well. EASY WHISKEY broke sharply, set a pressured pace on the rail, dueled in the second turn but tired in the stretch. WOULD I WOULD I raced three wide into the first turn, gained ground in the second turn but showed a mild bid from four wide. LAKE HOUSE drifted out entering the first turn, contended evenly but tired in the stretch.
