SURFIN' SYDNEY dueled on the rail, edged ahead after the quarter pole, rallied and held well. SQUIGGLY GETS EVEN broke well, stalked the pace on the rail, gained ground in the backstretch and finished second best. DENNIKA dueled to the outside but weakened after the quarter pole and dropped back. SMOKIN JANE raced evenly to the outside, gained steadily in the backstretch but weakened and finished evenly. NASTY lacked speed, trailed and passed tiring rivals. SWEET ESTEEM saved ground, made a middle move but flattened out. CARLOTTA DEL SOL stalked the pace to the outside but weakened in the backstretch and dropped back.
